



Habitat: Deciduous aspen/birch dominated forest with grass and forb understory, northern exposure.



- 1) Flowers on long terminal raceme, flowers open from base.
- 2) Alternating lanceolate leaves



Lanceolate leaves lighter underneath, distinctly veined on underside.



- 1) Long inferior ovary.
- 2) 4 obovate petals, 4 long slender sepals.
- 3) Long stigma, pubescent at base of style (only faintly visible on this specimen, given my cheap phone camera).
- 4) This one had 9 stamens, most of the flowers appear to have 8.
- 5) Single intact flower showing long inferior ovary.
